Spelling the /oi/ Sound

There are two different ways that we can spelling the /oi/ sound: oi and oy.

Example Words

foil
boy
poy
coin

Week Two

Homophones

Homophones are words that sound the same but are spelled differently.

Homophone pairs such as “hole” and “whole” are spelled differently because they have different meanings. Thinking of the meaning of a homophone will help you remember the spelling.

Example Pairs

piece | peace
waste | waist
fur | fir
their | there

Week Three

Contractions

In a **contraction**, the apostrophe takes the place of the missing letters when the two words are combined.

n't → not
'd → had or would
've → have

Example Words

had not → hadn't
he would → he'd
they had → they'd
I have → I've
