## Homophones

Homophones are words that sound the same but are spelled differently. Homophone pairs such as "hole" and "whole" are spelled differently because they have different meanings. Thinking of the meaning of a homophone will help you remember the spelling.

## Contractions

In a **contraction**, the apostrophe takes the place of the missing letters when the two words are combined.

> $n't \rightarrow not$ 'd  $\rightarrow$  had or would 've  $\rightarrow$  have

#### **Example Words**

had not  $\rightarrow$  hadn't he would  $\rightarrow$  he'd they had  $\rightarrow$  they'd I have  $\rightarrow$  l've
